The Mondavi Center is a venue where artists from around the world perform.

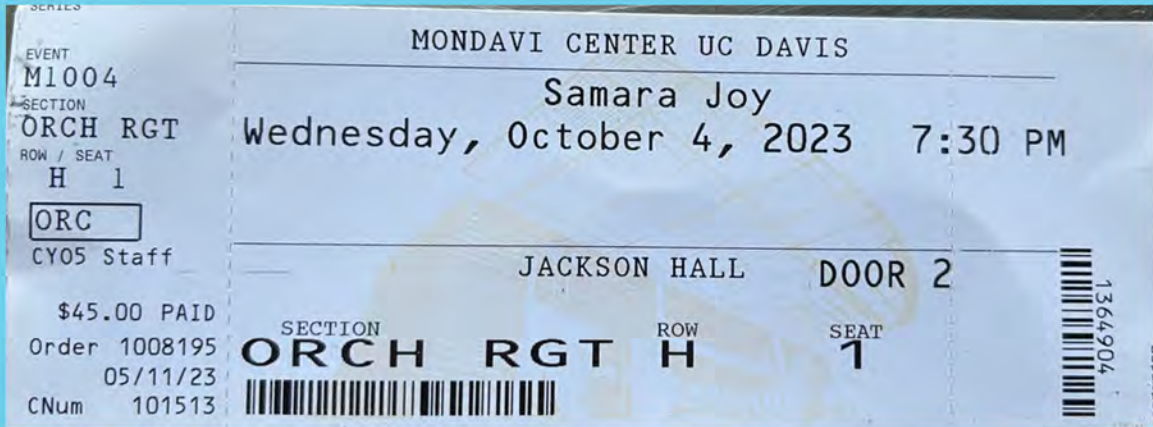
I will enter the building through the main lobby doors.

I may have to wait in line for the bathroom.





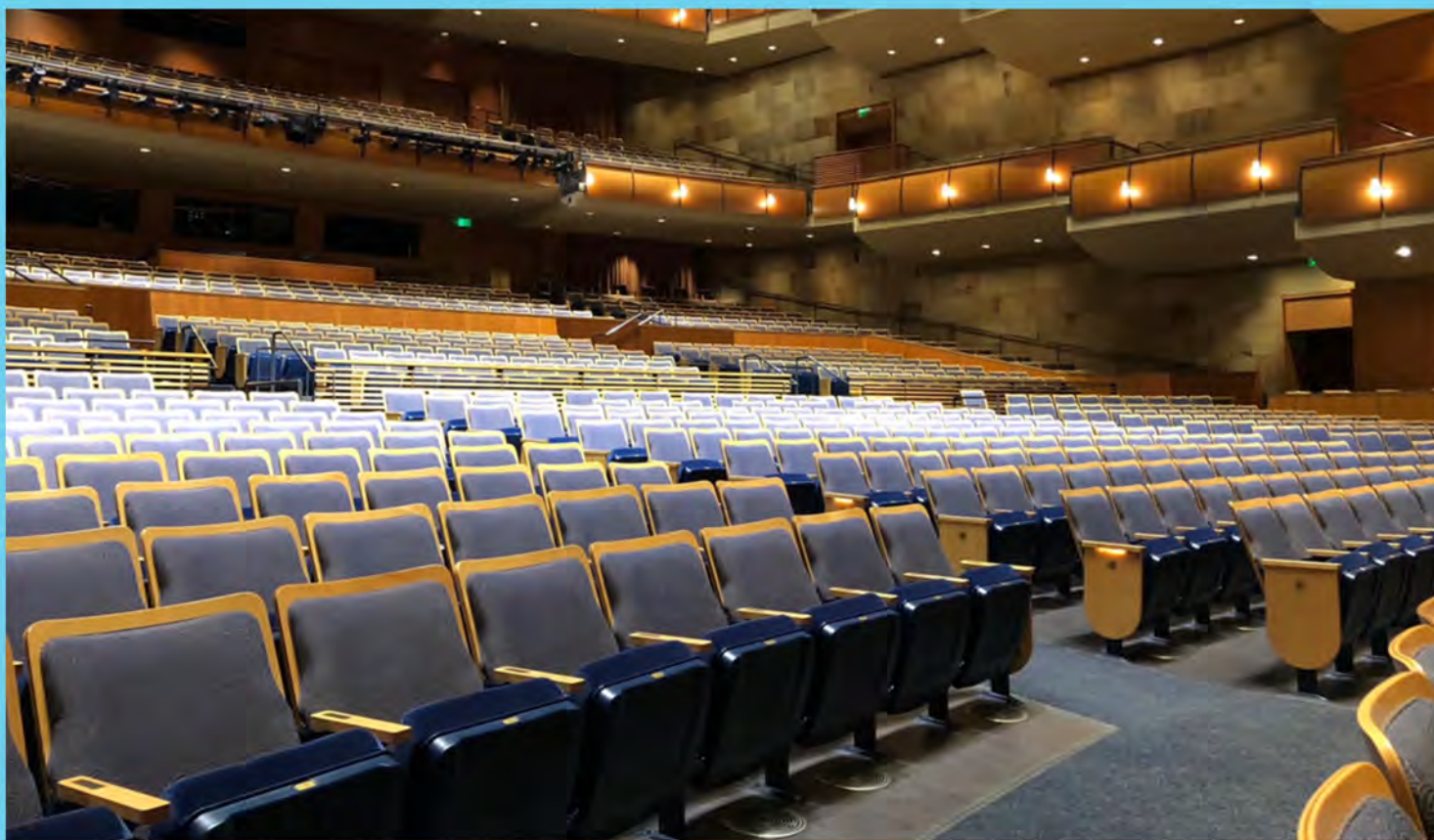
Bathrooms

The Musicians

Before the musicians start the concert, they may take a few moments to tune their musical instruments. It is good to be quiet while they do this. Once they finish, they will start to play!



Appreciation

People clap when they like what they are seeing and hearing. People clap only for a short time then the clapping is over.

I can clap if I like what I hear or see.



Quiet Space

If I need a break during the show, I can go into a quiet area in the lobby until i'm ready to return.



After the Concert

After the show, the performers will come out to the lobby and I can meet them and ask them questions.



Leaving the Center

When the show is over, I might go use the bathroom before I leave.

The bathroom might be crowded and I will have to wait my turn.

After I am finished, I will leave the lobby through the front doors.
